# Kingsbury alumni donate \$1,500

What began as a series of class reunions, grew into an attempt to combine the fun of class reunions, playing golf and raising money for struggling students to enter college or continue their college careers through graduation.

The Kingsbury Alumni Association Inc. became incorporated as a 501c3 nonprofit corporation in 1997.

This year the group donated \$1,500 to Kingsbury High, giving a check to Principal Terrance Brown for the school's use.

Since 1999 the association has also donated to local charities such as Make-A-Wish foundation, Ronald McDonald House at St. Jude and bought flowers for several funerals of classmates or faculty members.

"Our reason for being is to run an annual golf tournament, usually in June, to generate funds for higher education scholarships to award to Kingsbury High School graduates, sons/daughters of Kingsbury graduates, and now grandchildren of Kingsbury graduates," said alumni association president Wendell Payne.

In 2006, \$1,500 was donated to the Kingsbury Athletic Department for new uniforms for the entire baseball team to commemorate the 40th anniversary of the school's 1966 State Champion baseball team.

Additionally, since we began we have awarded more than \$40,000 in college scholarships.
